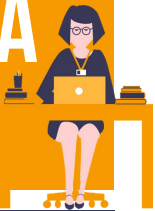


CURRICULUM POSTERS

TO SUPPORT DISENGAGED PUPILS!

While supporting a pupil who was feeling disengaged with one of their subjects we discussed the career they were striving for, examined all the various subject career pathways and identified where this career appeared. We then looked at the skills associated with these subjects and many of them crossed over. It became apparent that the subject they had felt lacked purpose actually had a direct skill link to their aspirational career.

AS A STARTER TASK!

Link the skill from the Learning Intention to a skill for the future and identify a possible career route in which you might use the learning from that lesson. Pupils found this very interactive and by laminating the posters they could be used repeatedly. This also supported the delivery of the Careers Education Standard within the lesson.



TO SUPPORT SUBJECT CHOICE!

During subject choice interviews Guidance staff used the posters to engage parents and pupils in possible career pathways. This then led to a shared confidence when coursing.
