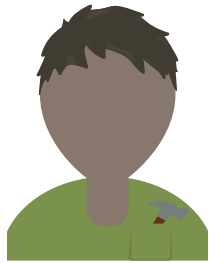

There will be an estimated **9,900** job openings in the Construction Sector over the next 10 years in **Edinburgh, Midlothian and East Lothian**



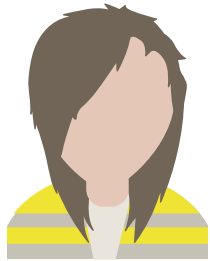
Carpenter or Joiner

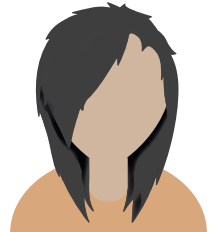

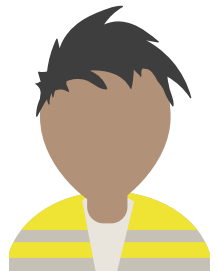
